Most are caught for texting or talking on their mobile phones, but authorities are stunned at the thousands every month refusing to strap themselves in. If caught, motorists can enjoy a \$300-plus fine and three demerit points. Motorists who see someone using a mobile while driving can report the offence to Police Link on 13 14 44.

joined along the way bringing the tally to 21 making quite a spectacle and catching the eye of many onlookers as the group rolled into town.


