Roadside Drug Testing Units Qld.

The Roadside Drug Testing Unit (RDTU) has expanded in staff numbers and fleet vehicles since it was implemented in December 2007.

The unit is based in the Brisbane metropolitan area, but officers, vehicles and equipment from Roadside Drug Testing Unit are deployed in all regions of the state.

"Studies have shown that drivers who take drugs are far more likely to be involved in a crash. Random roadside drug testing was introduced as a way to make our roads safer." State Traffic Operations Inspector Sean O'Neill said.

The RDTU began with nine staff members and has grown to 25 officers and two administration officers.

Their fleet of vehicles has grown significantly and now has three Mercedes Sprinter buses, three Toyota Hilux utilities, a Toyota Kluger station wagon and three Holden Commodore station wagons. This allows the unit to respond to multiple requests for assistance right across Queensland.

During the 2010/2011 year, the Roadside Drug Testing Unit conducted 23,961 roadside drug tests statewide resulting in 598 positive drug tests.

With the gradual increase in resources since its inception, the RDTU has steadily increased its testing capabilities.

There are three 'relevant' drugs that the police test for using a saliva test: Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC also commonly known as marijuana); Methyl amphetamines (Speed) and Methylenedioxymethamphetamine – known as MDMA or Ecstasy).

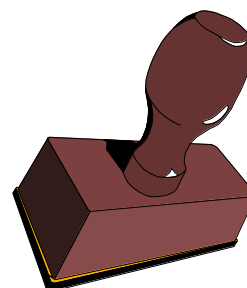
MINUTES OF CABOOLTURE REGIONAL CAR CLUB

Business Arising from the Previous Minutes

Those wishing to sell, swap or buy are to forward the details to Lance, the club webmaster. Details will be placed on the website for a period of 30 days.

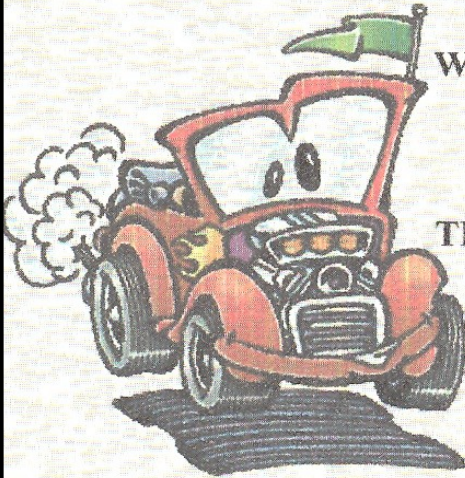

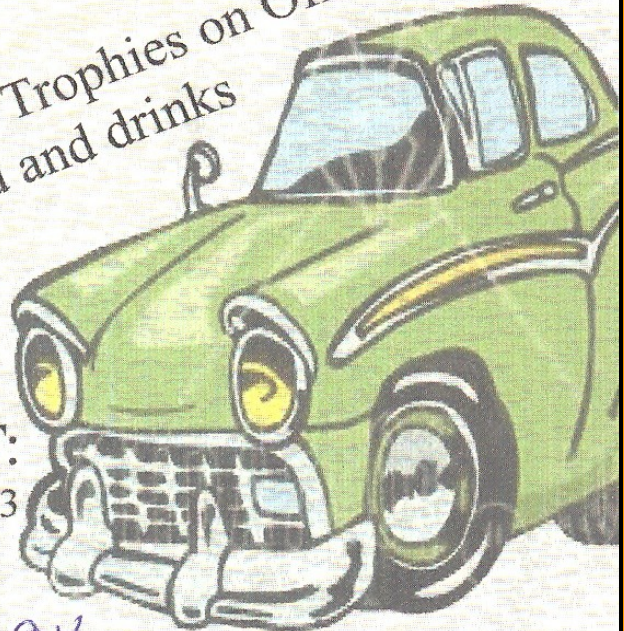
