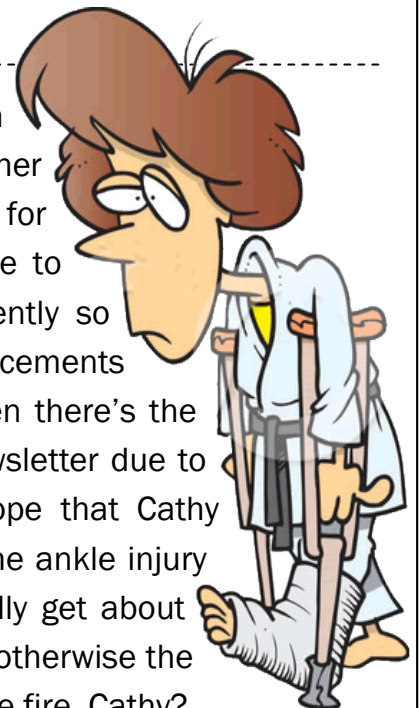

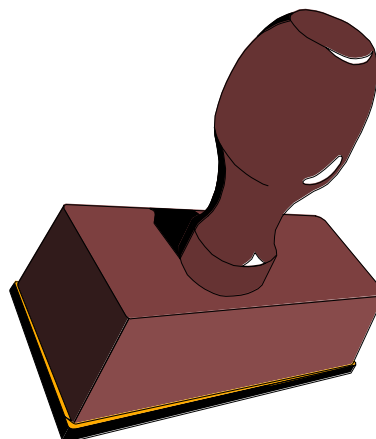
1. The President, Dennis Siedel, declared the Meeting open at 7:40pm and welcomed and thanked those present.

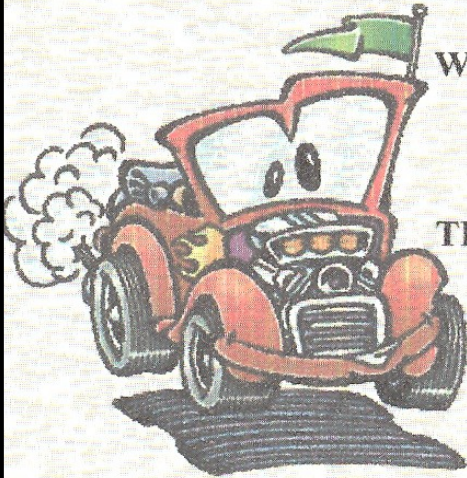

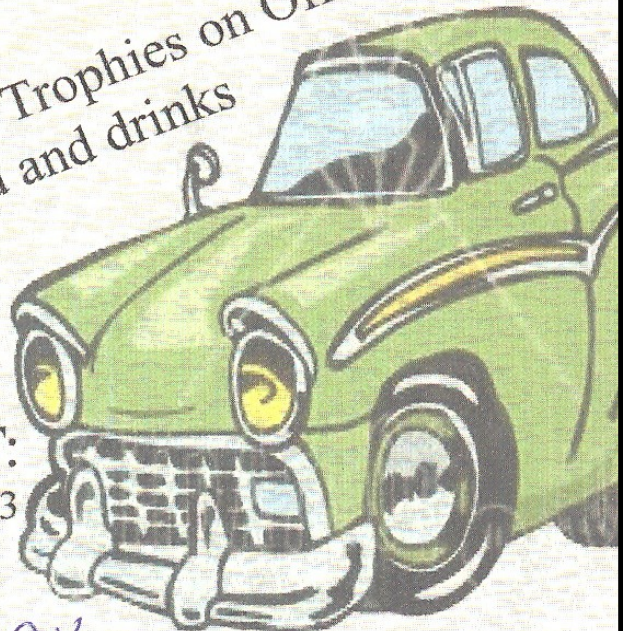
