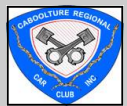

General Business

10. Annual General Meeting. The AGM will be held on 4th September. All members encouraged to attend. Members needed to fill some positions.
11. Department of Fair Trading Annual Return. The Department of Fair Trad-

ing Annual Return is due. To be completed soon as possible following the AGM. For Action: Secretary.

12. Endeavour Foundation Rally 2013. Moved Kevin Lewis and seconded Tim Howe that a sum of \$1000.00 be donated to the Endeavour Foundation. Cheque to be given to rally participant, Bruce Harts-horn. For Action: Treasurer. Carried.

13. Support for 'Friends of the Street'. Club to cover the vehicle registration fee for 'Friends of the Street'. To be reviewed yearly. Moved John Hogg and seconded Kevin Lewis. Carried.

14. Donations. Cyril Bates recommended that the amount of funds donated should be limited in order to preserve funds for contingency purposes. As the Club's only source of income is the annual show 'n shine and swap meet, funds needed to be preserved in case the event is cancelled due to adverse weather conditions; as what could have happened this year. In view of this, it was agreed that a maximum sum of \$500 per month be approved for donations. John Hogg recommended that a sum of \$7000 be placed in a term deposit to meet contingencies. Topic to be discussed further at the forthcoming AGM.

15. Breast Cancer - Girls Night, Friday 11th October. A proposal was made to make a donation to the 'Breast Cancer - Girls Night Out' charity event to be held at the Centenary Lakes Sports Club, Caboolture. Rather than a financial donation, Victoria Lewis suggested that the Club purchase a framed and signed picture of 'Pink' (singer/song writer) for presentation at the function for raffling. Moved Victoria Lewis, seconded Bob Farmer. For Action: Victoria Lewis. Carried.

16. Show 'N Shine/Swap Meet - Meeting with Caboolture Show Society. Cathy outlined the events of a meeting between CRCC and the Caboolture Show Society on 16th July which was convened to discuss differences between CRCC and the Society. An outcome of the meeting was a proposal to formulate a Memorandum-Of-Understanding (MOU) between CRCC and the Society, however upon discussion amongst members, it was suggested that CRCC write to the Society and request an operating procedure or a set of guidelines by which CRCC can follow at future show 'n shine and swap meet events.

17. Cathy presented a draft MOU which will form the basis for such a document if needed. For Action: Secretary to write to the Caboolture Show Society.

18. Ratification of Expenditure. Cathy requested reimbursement for out-of-pocket-expenses associated with the Show 'N Shine and Swap Meet; namely the purchase and printing of signs and other material. Value \$119.00. Moved Lance Haslewood seconded Dave Kuhrt that the amount be reimbursed. Carried.

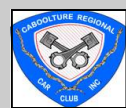

Annual General Meeting ~ 4th September



The Annual General Meetings (AGM) will be held on Wednesday the 4th September 2013 at the Barr Oval Complex, Beerburrum Road, Caboolture, commencing at 7:30pm. Members are encouraged to support their club by attending the meeting. As per normal, all positions will be declared vacant and nominations will be sought to fill these positions. These positions are:

- **President:** The President is responsible for fulfilling the Club Mission by leading the Club Executive Committee and ensuring that the Club Objectives are met.
- **Vice President:** The Vice-President is responsible for assisting the President to fulfill the Club Mission and other activities of the Club as directed by the President.
- **Secretary:** The Secretary is responsible for initiating, recording and maintaining the Club hardcopy records including, minutes and correspondence.
- **Treasurer:** The Treasurer is responsible for the collection, custody and payment of all Club accounts, and for the correct maintenance, recording and reporting of the details of these activities and transactions.
- **Runs Coordinator:** The Runs Coordinator has overall responsibility for all Club runs, and in particular, the development of an advance club runs calendar.
- **Membership Officer:** The Membership Officer has overall responsibility for the maintenance of the Club membership records, and the administration of membership-related tasks.
- **Club Dating Officer (Special Interest Vehicle Scheme):** The Club Dating Officer (Club Registration Officer) is responsible inspecting vehicles to ensure that they comply and meet the requirements of the Department of Transport and Main Roads to be eligible for registration as 'Special Interest Vehicles'. The Club Dating Officer must maintain a register of Club special interest vehicles and ensure that the Club obligations of holders of such vehicle registrations are fulfilled in accordance with Club rules.
- **Queensland Historic Motoring Council Representative:** The Queensland Historic Motoring Council Representative is responsible for attending the monthly council meetings by representing the Caboolture Regional Car Club.
- **Swap Meet Officer:** The Swap Meet Officer is responsible for coordinating the Club's yearly swap meet and liaising with relevant authorities.
- **Show 'N Shine Coordinator:** The Show 'N Shine Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the Club's yearly Show 'N Shine which includes the procurement of trophies and gathering of sponsorship and liaising with relevant authorities.
- **Barr Oval Delegate:** The Barr Oval Delegate is responsible for attending meetings of the Barr Oval Committee by representing the Caboolture Regional Car Club.
- **Newsletter Editor:** The Newsletter Editor is responsible for the compilation and distribution of the monthly newsletter to financial members.
- **Webmaster:** The webmaster is responsible for the electronic communications of the Club, and in particular, the development and maintenance of the Club's web-site.

Maleny at a Glance



Special Interest Vehicle Registration (SIV) ~ 'Concessional' or 'Club Rego'

To qualify for 'Concessional' or 'Club Rego' registration, new members must attend four (4) Club-sanctioned activities or Club meetings within the first six (6) months of membership. Thereafter new and present members holding concessional registration must attend four (4) Club-sanctioned activities or Club meetings each year in order to retain the concessional registration. Failure to comply may result in a recommendation to the Department of Transport and Main Roads for forfeiture of the registration.

Some facts for Special Vehicle Registration:

Registering your vehicle under the Special Interest Vehicle Registration Concession Scheme:

Historic Vehicles

You will need to follow the standard registration procedures for a vehicle as well as completing a Vehicle Registration Concession Application (form F3937) and providing the following documents as proof of eligibility:

Club Membership: Evidence of current membership with an incorporated vehicle club or association must be provided at the time of application for the concession.

Historic Vehicle and Dating Certificate: A dating officer (or club official) of an incorporated vehicle club or association must inspect the vehicle to certify the vehicle's authenticity and year of manufacture, that is, no structural modifications have been made that would deem it as manufactured at the date it was modified. This certificate must be on club letterhead or other official club documentation and include the chassis number or vehicle identification number.

Vehicles fitted with a modification plate, code LH10 are not eligible for a special interest vehicle concession.

Vehicles registered under the scheme have certain limitations placed on their use. This is reflected in the reduced fees and compulsory third party insurance premium. Registered operators must confine their vehicle's use to:

- Participating in rallies organised by incorporated vehicle clubs.
- Participating in processions for which a Special Events Permit has been issued under the Transport Operations (Road Use Management –Accreditation and Other Provisions) Regulation 2005.
- Exhibiting the vehicle in displays, fetes or similar functions conducted for religious, charitable or educational purposes.
- Ceremonial purposes (weddings, formals) involving immediate family members provided this is not done for fee or reward. Immediate family means parents, grandparents, sons, daughters, grandchildren but not extended family relationships such as nephews and nieces.
- Preparing for, proceeding to, and returning from the above activities.
- Direct travel to and from an Approved Inspection Station (AIS) for the purposes of obtaining a safety certificate before offering the vehicle for sale.
