A brief duty statement of committee positions are as follows:

□ **President**: Responsible for fulfilling the Club Mission by leading the Club Executive Committee and ensuring that the Club Objectives are met.

□ **Vice President**: Responsible for assisting the President and Secretary to fulfil the Club Mission and other activities of the Club as directed by the President.

Performs the duties of the President and/or Secretary if they are unable to do so.

□ **Secretary**: Responsible for initiating, recording and maintaining the Club hardcopy records including, minutes and correspondence.

□ **Treasurer**: Responsible for the collection, custody and payment of all Club accounts, and for the correct maintenance, recording and reporting of the details of these activeties and transactions.

□ **Membership Officer**: Responsible for the maintenance of the Club membership records, administration of membership-related tasks and ordering and procurement of regalia and merchandise.

Experience with Microsoft Access a definite advantage.

□ **Editor**: The Editor is responsible for the compilation and distribution of the monthly newsletter to financial members. Experience in Microsoft Word and Publisher an advantage.

□ **Run Coordinator**: The Run Coordinator has overall responsibility for all Club runs, and in particular, the development of an advance club runs calendar.

□ **Club Dating Officer** (Special Interest Vehicle Scheme): Responsible inspecting vehicles to ensure that they comply and meet the requirements of the Department of Transport and Main Roads to be eligible for registration as 'Special Interest Vehicles'. The Club Dating Oficer must maintain a register of Club special interest vehicles and ensure that the Club obligations of holders of such vehicle registrations are fulfilled in accordance with Club Rules.

□ **Show, Shine and Swap Coordinator**: Responsible for coordinating the Club's yearly show, shine and swap event and liaising with relevant authorities.

□ **Property Officer**: Responsible for the accountability of Club assets and the maintenance of a Property Assets Register.

□ **Webmaster**: Responsible for the electronic communications of the Club, and in particular, the development and maintenance of the Club's web-site and Facebook accounts. Experience in web authoring software such as Adobe Dreamweaver CS6 and Wordpress a definite advantage.

□ Workshop Coordinator: Coordination of DIY workshops.

□ Christmas Function Coordinator: Coordinate the Club's yearly Christmas function.

□ **Catering Convenor**: Setup the monthly meeting supper service. Procurement of relevant consumables.

The AGM will commence at 7:00pm sharp and members are encouraged to support their club by attending the meeting.

All positions are up for grabs, but most importantly, one must be a financial member in order to nominate or be nominated for a position or to cast a vote.

Current Membership Cards will need to be produced and membership numbers be recorded in the attendance book on the night in order to vote.

Nomination forms will be available at the August Meeting or on request from the secretary before the night and should be submitted to the secretary before the meeting. If no written nominations are received the chair may call nominations from the floor.

Proxies. A member entitled to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting may appoint a person to attend and vote at the meeting as the member's proxy.

A proxy may be appointed by returning the proxy form (attached) to the Secretary at PO Box 1668 Caboolture 4510, at least 24 hours before the commencement of the meeting or presenting a completed proxy form to the Secretary prior to the meeting.

RUN ETIQUETTE

To ensure that their vehicle has adequate fuel to reach the destination or the next planned fuel stop. Refuelling the vehicle should be done before refuelling oneself! Run departures will not be delayed for those vehicles needing last-minute fuel particularly if there has been an ample opportunity to fill-up before the run departs.

Urged to be on time for the commencement of the run and/or event. Should a member be running late and wishes to commence the run with the group, he/she should contact the run coordinator. Similarly if members wish to join en-route.

Urged to keep together wherever possible, particularly in built-up areas. This will minimise the necessity of continually stopping to regroup which can be hazardous. It is realised that keeping together in built-up areas can be difficult, but often those caught at traffic lights will catch-up to those in front as they themselves are slowed by lights.

Not permitted to overtake the designated run leader. However participants may move about within the group, overtaking when safe and legal.

Encouraged to remain with the group until the agreed dispersal point at the end of the event. This also applies to static events such as car shows.

Encouraged to carry a small portable UHF CB radio and set to Channel 9. Such radios are relatively inexpensive, and have ranges varying from around one to five kilometres. They are invaluable and a medium by which to keep informed about what is going on, and to let the group know if you have become separated or broken-down.




