Gary Yeo's Detomasa Pantera

I was born in the Maserati factory in Modena Italy in 1974. Detomaso Pantera L which stands for Lusso which is luxury in Italian. The word Pantera translates to panther. Fully independent suspension, rack and pinion steering, 4 wheel disc brakes and AC were standard features. Transaxle came from the GT40 le mans winning car. Only approx. 7500 Panteras were produced. I spent most of my life in California enjoying the warm climate before migrating to Australia approx 9 years ago. My big ugly bumpers that were fitted to comply with US collision laws were removed and replaced with the slim Euro spec bumperettes. I fell into a state of disrepair and unroadworthy condition until my current owner purchased me just over 3 years ago. My body was in good condition however I needed extensive work on the brakes, cooling, electrical and ac systems. The 351 Cleveland engine has been removed for preservation. A worthy substitute has been fitted which came from a donor AU xr8 which is the last incarnation of the Windsor engine family. Injector size was increased from 190 cc to 600 cc and driven by a Haltec Elite ECU. Dual wide band oxygen sensors monitor the exhaust gasses and dual knock sensors detect any preignition. Breathing is assisted by twin Garrett GT28 ball bearing water cooled turbos with water to air intercooling. Boost pressure is regulated at 13 psi and power is in the vicinity of 550 to 600 hp. 98 octane fuel must be used. GVM is approx. 1300kgs. GTS spec wheels 15 x 10's were recently manufactured in Italy and fitted to house my 295 rear tyres.

RUN ETIQUETTE

To ensure that their vehicle has adequate fuel to reach the destination or the next planned fuel stop. Refuelling the vehicle should be done before refuelling oneself! Run departures will not be delayed for those vehicles needing last-minute fuel particularly if there has been an ample opportunity to fill-up before the run departs.

Urged to be on time for the commencement of the run and/or event. Should a member be running late and wishes to commence the run with the group, he/she should contact the run coordinator. Similarly if members wish to join en-route.

Urged to keep together wherever possible, particularly in built-up areas. This will minimise the necessity of continually stopping to regroup which can be hazardous. It is realised that keeping together in built-up areas can be difficult, but often those caught at traffic lights will catch-up to those in front as they themselves are slowed by lights.

Not permitted to overtake the designated run leader. However participants may move about within the group, overtaking when safe and legal.

Encouraged to remain with the group until the agreed dispersal point at the end of the event. This also applies to static events such as car shows.

Encouraged to carry a small portable UHF CB radio and set to Channel 9. Such radios are relatively inexpensive, and have ranges varying from around one to five kilometres. They are invaluable and a medium by which to keep informed about what is going on, and to let the group know if you have become separated or broken-down.
