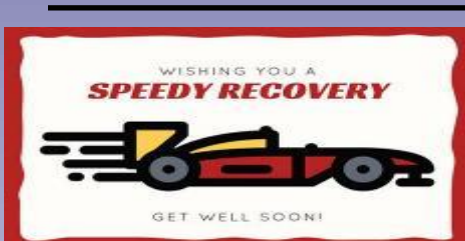

Speaking of which I think its about time I talked about the new C8. It was released to the public about a month or so ago.

**Engine:** 6.2-liter V8, 495 hp and 470 lb-ft of torque (with performance exhaust) / **Transmission:** Eight-speed dual-clutch / **0-60:** less than 3 seconds, with launch control.

**The original development mule for the new C8 Corvette, a wide body Commodore Ute with a big wing and an engine in the bed. 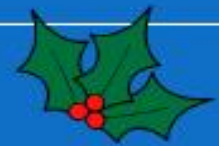

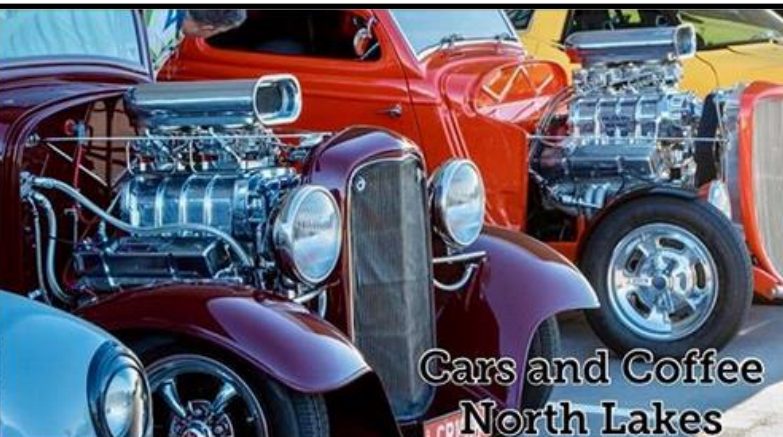

## **RUN ETIQUETTE**

To ensure that their vehicle has adequate fuel to reach the destination or the next planned fuel stop. Refuelling the vehicle should be done before refuelling oneself! Run departures will not be delayed for those vehicles needing last-minute fuel particularly if there has been an ample opportunity to fill-up before the run departs.

Urged to be on time for the commencement of the run and/or event. Should a member be running late and wishes to commence the run with the group, he/she should contact the run coordinator. Similarly if members wish to join en-route.

Urged to keep together wherever possible, particularly in built-up areas. This will minimise the necessity of continually stopping to regroup which can be hazardous. It is realised that keeping together in built-up areas can be difficult, but often those caught at traffic lights will catch-up to those in front as they themselves are slowed by lights.

Not permitted to overtake the designated run leader. However participants may move about within the group, overtaking when safe and legal.

Encouraged to remain with the group until the agreed dispersal point at the end of the event. This also applies to static events such as car shows.

Encouraged to carry a small portable UHF CB radio and set to Channel 9. Such radios are relatively inexpensive, and have ranges varying from around one to five kilometres. They are invaluable and a medium by which to keep informed about what is going on, and to let the group know if you have become separated or broken-down.

13. **Webmaster** – Lance Haslewood reminded those present that the current Facebook Pages would be shut down to night to be replaced by new ones created using Club ID.
14. **Newsletter Editor** – Newsletter went out on Tuesday. Please advise David if you have not received the email.

**16. General Business :**

- I. Ian Rodgers -Dirt drags next Sunday at Archer Field, Neurum, as fund raiser for the Endeavour foundation. Camping available.
- II. Cathy Kuhrt asked that the Santa Jar from last year's Christmas party be returned.
- III. Secretary, Olive Jones raised the issue of membership fees. She highlighted the fact that the Club's annual outings to simply run as a club were barely covered by the current Membership Fees and if it wasn't for the profit from the annual Swap, Show & Shine many of the benefits that the members currently enjoy could not be afforded. This was backed up by the current Annual Financial Report that showed we had in fact operated with a small loss for the past year. After some discussion Ian Rodgers moved and John Fenech seconded that we address membership fees at the next meeting. Motion carried.
- IV. John Dickson took the floor. Below is the speech he delivered, as provided by him.

I would like to thank those that have supported me, have wanted me to continue on in the committee, and also to thank Kevin again, for actually stating his opinion, instead of some that are whispering it to others, while I'm not present, for this you have my utmost respect.

I am now in my eighth year at this club, and have been involved with 4 committees, each one becoming more bitter than the last ...

I will however no longer stand for any positions, while there are currently present, certain individuals, on the committee.

At the end of the last GM, I privately stated to Olive, in the presence of John Fenech, formally protesting the minutes of the last committee meeting, and the fact that the previous meetings minutes, that were not right, and had been voted on and carried, that they be changed to include that Lance had threatened to shoot me at the May committee meeting, still had not been updated to state so.

At that same July meeting, I also protested Olives belittling comments, and follow up berating of me on the secret committee Facebook group, over me advising members of the committee meeting date.

This was met with what can only be described as bordering on hysterics, from both Olive and Noel, with Noel issuing several threats toward me.

The meeting ended with Noel stating that either Olive resigned or their marriage was over, with Olive then tearing out the pages from the minutes book, and resigning, simply from me, protesting, her treatment of me. To this date, no one, has contacted me, regarding my protest of the minutes, and given that threats were made against me, this I feel, should have been addressed.

Earlier, when I was asked for my version of what I wanted in those minutes, by Vince, given that the meeting

had ended without them being recorded, I stated on the post in the committee group, that it needed to be discussed with more than one person, as a singular account, would lead to disputes, so from that, Olive recorded in the minutes, that I declined to comment, I also protested that was incorrect.

In my opinion, minutes have at times, at best been scant, and at other times, appear to be skewed in certain directions, that do not fully represent the required legislated, full and accurate account of meetings.

I am at the point now, of stating this publicly, as nothing has been done, to address both the threats made, nor recording the accurate account of them.

Plus, the requirement of changing the minutes, so that people can actually see what has been going on, will soon vanish, as all of these events, will disappear into the abyss of requiring submitting a written request to view them, because, ironically, after I had made the protest, and successfully had the minutes changed to include Lance threatening to shoot me, a decision was made to delete all the Facebook pages and start new ones, thus removing all records of these events from the purview of the membership, thereby sweeping it all under the carpet and making it all go away.

To me, that seems a little more than a coincidence.

So many good people have been pushed out, and others just simply not returned, not only because of the furor over donations, and committee thinning, but also because of the bullying, and intimidation by some, against others, and yes, probably even by me complaining about it.

However, if nothing is said, how will anything change, or people be held accountable, for their actions?

A few years ago, I was duped by Lance into joining the coup against Devin, and even used as part of the argument to dismiss him from the club altogether, over Devin shirt fronting me in the kitchen.

Having now been on the receiving end myself, I feel embarrassed by my actions in the past, and feel that I owe him an apology, so if anyone still associates with Devin, please advise him so.

However, having stated all this, making threats against fellow members, without doubt, completely, and unequivocally warrants termination of membership, regardless of who it is.

For anyone to allow this to happen, and not take action on it, thereby condones such abhorrent behaviour, and they should be completely ashamed.

I'm done trying to do the right thing, only to be vilified for it.

I Thank you.

John Dickson accepted that the incoming committee would address this.

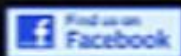
