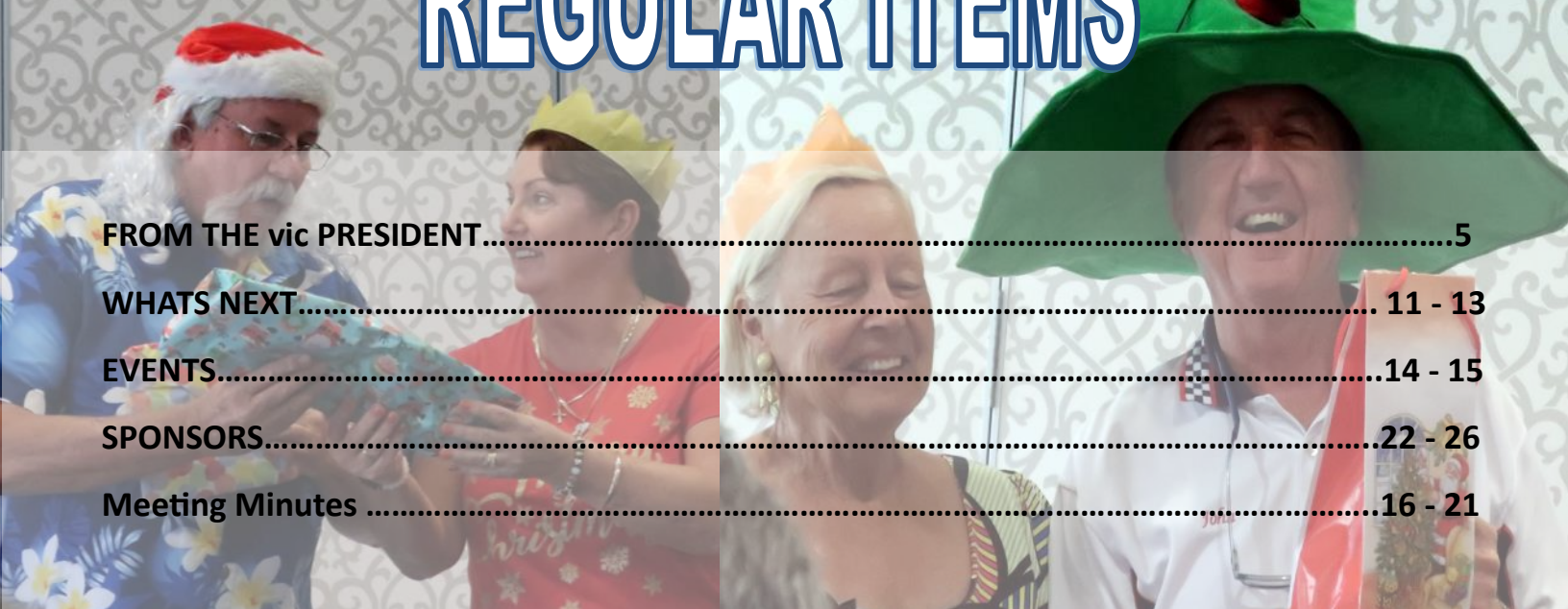

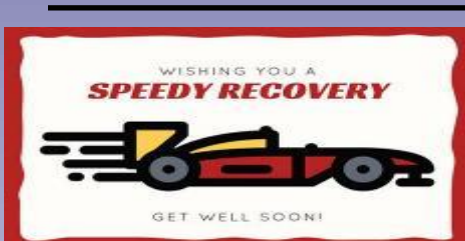

RUN ETIQUETTE

To ensure that their vehicle has adequate fuel to reach the destination or the next planned fuel stop. Refuelling the vehicle should be done before refuelling oneself! Run departures will not be delayed for those vehicles needing last-minute fuel particularly if there has been an ample opportunity to fill-up before the run departs.

Urged to be on time for the commencement of the run and/or event. Should a member be running late and wishes to commence the run with the group, he/she should contact the run coordinator. Similarly if members wish to join en-route.

Urged to keep together wherever possible, particularly in built-up areas. This will minimise the necessity of continually stopping to regroup which can be hazardous. It is realised that keeping together in built-up areas can be difficult, but often those caught at traffic lights will catch-up to those in front as they themselves are slowed by lights.

Not permitted to overtake the designated run leader. However participants may move about within the group, overtaking when safe and legal.

Encouraged to remain with the group until the agreed dispersal point at the end of the event. This also applies to static events such as car shows.

Encouraged to carry a small portable UHF CB radio and set to Channel 9. Such radios are relatively inexpensive, and have ranges varying from around one to five kilometres. They are invaluable and a medium by which to keep informed about what is going on, and to let the group know if you have become separated or broken-down.

Minutes of the general Meeting held at Stanmore Hall, Caboolture Historical Village, Beerburrum Road, Caboolture. Wednesday, 6 November, 2019

1. **Opening** – The Vice President, Rod Constable, declared the meeting open at 7.30pm and welcomed all present and advised:
 - As required by O.H & S, please make yourself, new members and visitors in particular, aware of the exits. The fire extinguishers is located at the rear of the hall, beside the stage and the southern end of the kitchen area along with a fire blanket.
 - In case of an emergency the assemble point on the opposite side of the building to the emergency site. For new members the toilets are to be found on the western side of the hall.
2. **Attendance** – As per 'Attendance Book'.
3. **Apologies** – Bevan Holding, Lance & Vicki Bower, Graham Roberts, Bob Boyle, Chris Cook, Barry Manks, Marian Sivula, Mitch & Victoria Lewis, Neil Flay, Daniel Williams, Ron Wise, Vince Blanchard, Debbie & Lance Suthers, Rob Brown, Carl Talboys and Craig O'Brien.
4. **New Members:** - Nil
5. **Visitors** – Stewart Stevenson – 1958 Ford Prefect
6. **Minutes of the Previous Meeting** – Moved by Secretary, Olive Jones and Seconded by Willy Hinds that the Minutes of the previous meeting be adopted as a true and accurate record. Motion carried.
7. **Business Arising from Minutes** –
 - A. Olive Jones asked that she be given the 'Right of Reply' to the statement made by Mr John Dickson at the September General Meeting. Her reply is as follows:

Fellow members tonight I wish to exercise my right of reply to the vial accusations levelled at Noel and myself at the September General Meeting.

Bullying, the repeated harassment of another person, is unacceptable anywhere any time but that is what I and a number of others on the past committee have been subjected to. Are you made to feel physically sick at the thought of attending one of our meetings, do you wonder where and when you are going to be verbally attacked when you are doing a voluntary job? Do you wonder what slanderous accusations are going to be levelled at you via social media just because you try to support this club and the community it purports want to help with its charitable work. Well since April this year this is what I have been subjected to and now the culprit, Mr John Dickson, wants my husband to stand in front of you and apologize for supposedly threatening him when all he said was words to the effect 'Any other man would knock you down for speaking to their wife like you have'. I ask the husbands amongst you would you let another man belittle and bully your wife?

The same individual is so brave that under the cover of the noise of the packing up of the chairs after the August General meeting he verbally attacked me because I hadn't supposedly done what he had wanted with regards making changes to minutes of meetings. He tells people he spoke to me in front of Mr John Fenech but when I asked Mr Fenech if he heard what was said to me he denied hearing anything. I chose to remain silent during his whole tirade. This was what I was also subjected to at the end of the July Committee Meeting. Did Mr Dickson ask the see the minutes that he was so upset about? No! I place before you all the folders containing all of the minutes of the General meeting and the Committee Meetings.

It greatly saddens me that I am placed in this position because of the actions of this individual who has sort 'play the victim' after listening to information given to him incorrectly by Mr Rob Blake(1), even when presented with corroborated evidence to the contrary. Members I ask you listen to the other side of this regretful situation.

The seat of venom goes back to the March, 2019 Management Committee Meeting. Regrettably the Vice President was not in attendance for personal reasons as was the case of his absence from the April General Meeting from which I was also absent. At the Management Committee meeting a motion was brought forward to reduce the number of positions that made up the said Committee. The reason for the motion was that at that time there were 21 positions making up the Management Committee and of those positions a number were vacant, a number of members held dual positions and a number of members who held positions rarely attended meetings. However for the meeting to be valid there need to be a quorum of 50% +1 of the office bearers to be present for the meeting to proceed. While we never had to abandon a meeting it was close number count at each meeting. Having this many on the Management Committee also meant that for General Meeting to go ahead we needed at least 40+ members present to make a quorum.

At this meeting it was clearly stated by myself that any change could not take effect until the September AGM. The minutes of this meeting clearly reflect this.

It was brought to question whether or not the Club actually needed a Vice President. The Constitution makes no mention of such a requirement and it was pointed out that many clubs run without one and that if the need arose anyone of the Management Committee could step up and fill the role, point in case was the last General Meeting that was Chaired by an ordinary member. After considered discussion and with no names being discussed only positions/roles, a list of future Management Committee Members was drawn up. Motion moved, seconded and voted on.

Knowing I was going to be absent from the April General Meeting I forwarded by email a report of the Management Committee Meeting to President Vince Blanchard to be read out at the said meeting. I have the records and file path dates (2) (3), which anyone who is computer literate will know cannot be altered, to prove my actions. This report was read out and seconded by John Hogg, who was at the March Committee Meeting and I am led to believe after some discussion voted on and carried by the members present on the night. In the meantime two committee members erred in their interpretation of when the changes to the Management Committee were to come into effect. One, Mr Lance Haselwood apologised for his mistake, the other, Mr Rob Blake continues to misconstrue the facts, even when the evidence clearly contradicts what he was telling others and in so doing bring about the chain of events which have now led the resignation from the club of his neighbours and to this current situation. Something he did again after the July Committee Meeting, but that is a whole other story. It is interesting that on both of these occasions when misinformation was subsequently disseminated he attended the said meetings on his own.

As I have already stated I was absent from the April General Meeting as was the Vice President, Mr Dickson. Mr Dickson subsequently contacted me via Messenger requesting the minutes of the Committee Meeting. I would normally have been able to supply him with this but had typed the said minutes up on my home computer and did not have a copy with me. I was away travelling at the time. I promised I would make them available as soon as I got home. In the midst of this I was called home as my mother had taken a turn for the worst. Three days after her death I posted the said minutes on the Committee's Facebook page. I'd like to add here that while this page is not available to the general membership there is nothing sinister in its content. It is simply a discussion page to save Committee members the time and expense of making copious phone calls when decisions need to be made between meetings. As soon as these minutes were posted Mr Dickson commented, and I quote "I do not believe, that this is an accurate representation, of the true minutes." How can he justify this statement when he was at neither the Committee Meeting in question nor the subsequent General meeting when the report was tabled by the president?

My response to this was that he would be given the opportunity to show how minutes should be taken at the May General Meeting as I would be absent as it was the day before my mother's funeral. Hence he took the minutes of the said meeting. I had provided him with a performer to use as a guide. Given the insinuation that I had in some way misrepresented the proceedings of the Committee meeting there was no way that I was going to edit the minutes presented to me for the records. They were full of grammatical errors, unrequired asides of comments between Mr Dickson and others and on the whole highly unprofessional. Also, given that our minutes are published as part of our newsletter and available on our website I consulted with our president then requested that this set of minutes not be included in the newsletter. It is my personal opinion and that of many others that if a perspective member was to read these minutes in our newsletter they would wonder what sort of club we were running. They were, however, posted to the general Facebook page for the members to read.

The May Committee Meeting saw a nasty confrontation between Mr Dickson and Mr Haslewood over a variety of issues including the issues that I have just outlined. John Fenech was in attendance and by the end of the meeting both men were basically given an ultimatum, either apologise to each other or walk away from their positions in the club. The men chose on the night to apologise and shake hands. For those present this was to be the end of the matters. History will now show that Mr Dickson was never going to end the matter there! This club is not responsible for things that have happened to individuals outside the club and cannot be expected to tread lightly because of the unknown.

Following the May Committee Meeting Noel wrote to our President, Vince Blanchard on 20th May pointing out how Mr Dickson was breaching the club constitution by bringing it into disrepute in our Club Community(4). Something that was later substantiated by a Facebook post by Kevin Lewis stating that Mr Dickson was attempting to 'turn the members against the committee' for something that had already been apologised for. This letter Vince chose to keep to himself to avoid further confrontation in the club. Noel also sent a written apology for Mr Dickson's discrediting of my minute taking. This apology has never been forthcoming. He says he apologised via email. I tender here a copy of the only email I received and it only refers to the death of my mother, for which I am grateful (5).

Following the July General Meeting, from which I was also absent due to ill health, Mr Dickson took it upon himself to post an invitation to the general club membership to attend the July Committee Meeting. Given that this is the job of either the President or the secretary I called him on his actions via the Committee Facebook Page. Mr Dickson in retaliation then selectively chose to publish a part of my message to him on the General Facebook page (6), a breach, as far as I am concerned of the confidentiality of things discussed on this page. I tender the full text of my response to him for anyone that wishes to read it. Mr Dickson continually points the finger a number of people laying claim that they are trying to 'run the club'. By the very nature of his actions, including questioning our treasurer Donna about her role when she stepped up to take on the Membership role and making snide remarks on the Committee page including 'you've had at least 2 opportunities to provide memberships lists to me' I think the boot is really on the other foot. It is Mr Dickson who seeks to run the club and he made this clearly evident with his domination of the conversation at the committee meeting held two weeks ago even though he is no longer a Committee member and was only a visitor at that meeting.

By this time I had become fed up with Mr Dickson's constant attempts to undermine the positions of Committee members. He was but one member of the committee but if decisions made by the majority weren't to his liking he made his dissent blatantly obvious and was like a dog with a bone. He wouldn't let go, talking over others until he got his own way, always with the argument, later, that he was doing it for the members! He forgets that Committee Members are Club members also.

Further to the October Committee Meeting, Mr Dickson once more showed his hand at his intimidation of me. Noel and I had set up the room at the sports club for the meeting. Tables for the Committee members and rows of chairs for the visitors. On entering the room Mr Dickson took it upon himself to rearrange the room to suit himself despite my protests. I might add he did this while I was alone with him in this meeting room.

Yes I did walk out of the July Committee Meeting, no I did not resign. I simply could not take any more of the bullying that I was being subjected to, similar to that he chose to issue at the September general meeting. Yes Noel was angry and what husband wouldn't be having to sit there and watch his wife being bullied and yes it was having a toll on the harmony in our marriage. Being secretary of any club is time consuming and at this point for all the time I was putting in all I was getting was abuse. Noel wanted me to throw the towel in but it's against my nature to give in to bullies.

How would you feel if you were accused of 'inaccurately representing the minutes of a meeting' and was 'scant' in recording them? I pride myself in recording the relevant goings on at our meetings. Please compare the minutes of the past two years against those of the preceding years. I ask you to check the minutes of the QHMC, they are recorded in the same manner with items listed as 'attached' but not posted to their website. Only an egotist wants his every word recorded for posterity.

Now I find that the said same person along with a number of his friends have been spreading it over social media, namely Facebook, that the 2018/2019 Committee were corrupt and that we funnelled off charitable donations to friends and that we needed to declare our interests. I take personal offence to this as Noel and I both abstained from voting or being involved in the decision of the amount of money that was allocated to a nomination for a charitable donation I put forward, unlike others in the past who secured huge donations for organisations based outside the Caboolture area because they could only do it once every three years! On every occasion I have always advised the General meetings of those organisations who have been put forward for consideration. I might also add here that suggestions for most if not all charitable donations come about because someone in the club knows of someone who could do with a helping hand as they struggle to support some community activity. Brandt King I think you owe the previous committee a huge apology for your derogatory statement in response to Mr Dickson's comments on Mrs Jan Blake's Facebook page, insinuating that the previous committees' decisions were in some way corrupt!(7)

For two months prior to the 2019 AGM I advertised and asked members to consider taking on positions in the club. Nomination forms were posted at meetings and in the newsletter, and yes those nomination forms had a closing date as they have had over the past few years. This is normal practise in any organisation. Those that nominated for positions at this AGM have now been accused of 'stacking the committee'. Every one of the 200+ members could just have easily put their hand up to take on roles. It could just as easily be said that those that did not nominate in writing were just sitting back to see who would do all the work while they sat back, some and I stress some, all ready to criticise everyone and everything.

Members I joined this club in 2015 with Noel and enjoyed the friendships we formed so much that I purchased my own car. All such clubs run on the generosity and time of volunteers. I did not volunteer to be abused and have my integrity questioned by someone who at every opportunity dominates the discussion or scorns and generally over talks the opinion of others. There is NEVER a topic brought up for discussion that he is not expert on and has to put forth his opinion about, and now it seems that if you, as the secretary, don't record his point of view in the minutes you are then to become the focus of his bully boy tactics. If that is the type of person you would prefer to have in this club I will happily submit my resignation because this is not the type of person I can work with in the current environment.

All I want now is for this whole situation to cease and for the Club to move forward.

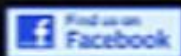
