#### Covid-19 (Coronavirus) and CRCC – Important information

#### **Dear Members**

The Management Committee have been in consultation with regards the evolving Covid-19 (Coronavirus) Pandemic and its ramifications for the functioning of our Club as it pertains to our Committee Meetings, monthly General Meetings and the Annual Swap, Show & Shine.

The following guidelines set down by the Commonwealth Government for gatherings of people impact us so:

- 1. We are unable to hold Committee Meetings at our normal venue of the Caboolture Sports Club due to the limiting of numbers at non-essential gatherings to under 100 in an enclosed space. The Sports Club is only able to operate on a very limited basis.
- 2. Our Swap Show & Shine is impacted by the limiting of numbers at non-essential gatherings outdoors to less than 500 people. (Information we become aware of this afternoon deems the Caboolture Markets as essential because of the food market stalls. Please review the ruling on their Facebook Page). Given that the numbers that normally attend our non-essential event range from 2000 to 3500 people, this puts our event well above these numbers even if they are spread over the duration and area of the event.
- 3. Advice to limit distances at social gatherings to more than 1.5 metres makes holding our General Meeting in the Stanmore Hall at the Caboolture Historical Village impractical, especially at supper time.
- 4. Those more susceptible to succumbing to the virus are persons over the age of 65 and in particular persons with pre-existing medical conditions. As you are no doubt aware the former pertains to the majority of our loyal members who regularly attend the monthly General Meetings of the Club.

## To address these the Committee has been in consultation and is now going to implement the following:

A. The Management Committee will continue to monitor this evolving situation and its impact on the Club either via telephone conferencing or our dedicated Caboolture Regional Car Club Committee Facebook page.

- B. The Swap, Show & Shine for 2020 is to be cancelled but the Club wishes to be mindful of how this may impact small businesses especially our trophy supplier. The Club may choose to still purchase trophies this year but not have them inscribed until they need to be used thus still providing some income to our supplier.
- C. Monthly General Meetings are to be suspended until at least the June 4<sup>th</sup> Meeting. The Committee will make a decision in the week prior to this date as to whether or not to suspend that meeting and continue to do so month by month. June, July and August are the months that usually see a spike in people contracting the 'normal flu' so we need to be very mindful of this added complication to the situation.
- D. Club Runs The March 29<sup>th</sup> Run to be led by David Spencer will still go ahead at this time. Its final destination will be in the Wivenhoe Dam area. David will contact the Fernvale Bakery to see if we are still able to attend their premises or the run may turn into a self-catered run to a park area. *However,* if you are any way unwell please be respectful of other Club members and do not take part on the day.
- E. Impromptu Runs The Committee urges you to take full advantage of this opportunity during this time. Take your car, food, drink and chair (or find a small business still operating to buy your food from) and head out into the great outdoors with your SIV registered car. Just remember to post your run on the Clubs Impromptu Facebook page. If you don't have Facebook access and a friend does get them to do it for you. NO NEED FOR IT OR YOU TO STAY ISOLATED TOTALLY, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY REQUIRED TO DUE TO OTHER CIRCUMSTANCE.

Be assured this is just a hiccup in life of our Club. We will be back bigger and stronger and the Management Committee will keep you informed.

Rod Constable has provided the technical article below to explain British car electrics.

Technical Topic, or should that read 'Not so technical topic'?

The editor, always on the lookout for good technical information, recently came across the following article on electrical systems, realising how it explained all, and would apply to aircraft as well as cars, it was 'lifted' from it's rightful place in the MG Car Club magazine 'Technical Torque'.

Joseph Lucas--Prince of Darkness, is a somewhat common slogan, particularly among owners of old British motor bikes. This is really quite unfair and displays a basic inability to comprehend the simple principles of a basic electrical system.

Forget all that nonsense about magnetic fields and the flow of electrons along a conductor, for it is just about that, nonsense, a myth put about by auto-electricians to support their lavish lifestyles at your expense. The reality is smoke! When you think about it, it all becomes startlingly obvious, smoke makes all electrical things function. If smoke escapes, the component stops working. For instance, the last time you had to grovel under your car to replace the starter motor, didn't it start smoking before it stopped working? Of course.

The wiring loom carries the smoke from one device to another, pumped around the system by the dynamo, and when a wire springs a leak it lets all the smoke out and everything stops. The starter motor requires lots of smoke to work properly, so it has a very thick wire going to it.

The battery stores up lots of smoke dissolved in the battery acid which is why they were once called accumulutors, until it became apparent that we home mechanics would twig the secret. Naturally, if you try to dissolve too much smoke in your battery it will escape through the little holes at the top, this is why those new-fangled batteries with sealed tops explode when they get too much smoke in them

But why is Joseph Lucas so maligned? Why are Lucas components more likely to leak smoke than say, Bosch or Marelli? Because Lucas is British and British things always leak. British engines leak oil, British sports cars leak rain, British hydrolastic units leak fluid, and British Governments leak military secrets. So naturally British electrical components leak smoke.

#### <u>RUN ETIQUETTE</u>

To ensure that their vehicle has adequate fuel to reach the destination or the next planned fuel stop. Refuelling the vehicle should be done before refuelling oneself! Run departures will not be delayed for those vehicles needing last-minute fuel particularly if there has been an ample opportunity to fill-up before the run departs.

Urged to be on time for the commencement of the run and/or event. Should a member be running late and wishes to commence the run with the group, he/she should contact the run coordinator. Similarly if members wish to join en-route.

Urged to keep together wherever possible, particularly in built-up areas. This will minimise the necessity of continually stopping to regroup which can be hazardous. It is realised that keeping together in built-up areas can be difficult, but often those caught at traffic lights will catch-up to those in front as they themselves are slowed by lights.

Not permitted to overtake the designated run leader. However participants may move about within the group, overtaking when safe and legal.

Encouraged to remain with the group until the agreed dispersal point at the end of the event. This also applies to static events such as car shows.

Encouraged to carry a small portable UHF CB radio and set to Channel 9. Such radios are relatively inexpensive, and have ranges varying from around one to five kilometres. They are invaluable and a medium by which to keep informed about what is going on, and to let the group know if you have become separated or broken-down.


