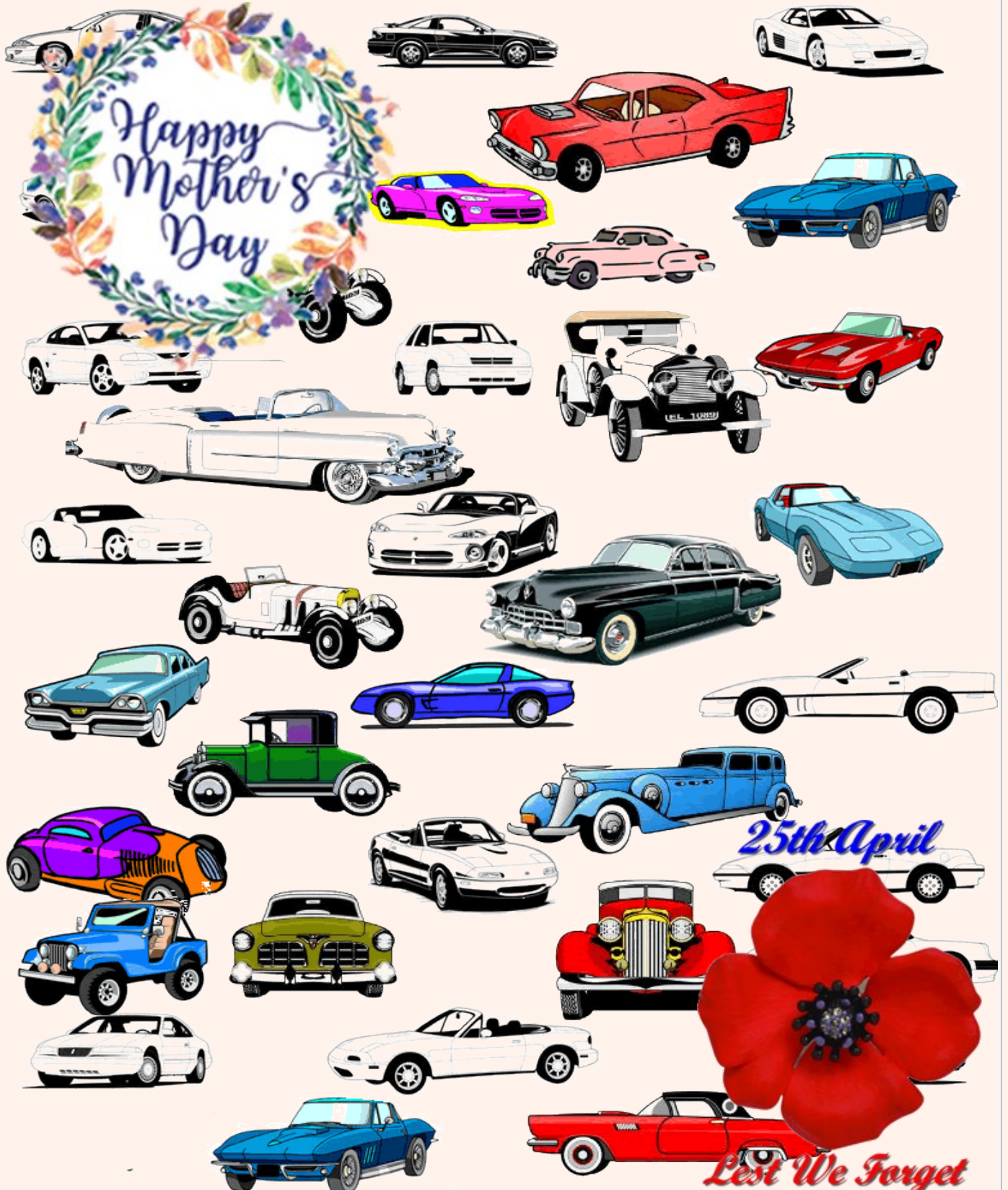

IMPROMPTU RUNS and COVID-19

With the relaxation by the Queensland Government at midnight, 1st May 2020, of some of the restrictions which had been put in place to help prevent the spread of COVID-19, CRCC members are once again able to post impromptu runs to the Club's Impromptu Run Facebook Page. However, posts will still be required to be approved by the pages' admin.

Before posting to the Impromptu Run Page, please refer to the 'Conditions of Use and Restrictions for SIV-registered Vehicles' as set-down by the Department of Transport and Main Roads, and also take into account the 2nd May State Government restrictions which include:

- Staying within a 50km radius of your principal place of residence.
- Practising social distancing and maintain a 1.5m spacing, and
- Only to be joined by those from your household or one other person who doesn't live with you.

The Club appreciates that we are all adults and therefore responsible for our own actions but asks that you do not request impromptu runs which breach these restrictions that may ultimately lead to expensive fines to the individual and also reflect adversely on the Club.

Please take advantage of these new conditions and take a run in your SIV-registered vehicle and maybe have that picnic in the park with your family, and maybe one other.

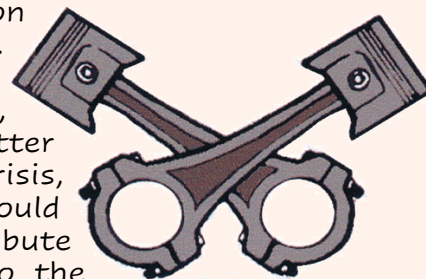
